We know you have been hearing a lot about Covid-19. CSCL is monitoring the situation closely and wanted to provide you with an update as to what CSCL is doing to safeguard those we support and their families.

- At this time, the Community Living Center will remain open; however, this is subject to change.
- At this time, SMART Connections will remain open; however, this is subject to change.
- Increased hand hygiene including hand sanitization is being encouraged/supported in all CSCL programs.
- Anyone who is sick or otherwise unwell is being asked to stay home.
- Family members and/or caregivers of individuals in a staffed residential service who are ill are asked **not to visit** the program until symptoms have otherwise resolved.
- Families and caregivers are asked to pick all individuals up from the Community Living Center no later than 3 o'clock daily until further notice as CLC staff will be thoroughly cleaning the building daily between 3pm and 4pm.

**If you have any flu-like symptoms you are asked to stay home!**

**Those who become unwell while accessing community inclusion programming, such as that at the Center, will be asked to go home.**
